

Bunton Painting
Standard Painting Practices
Interior:

I have tried to answer as many questions as possible with this sheet. Not all items will apply to every job and anything written on the estimate sheet will take priority over this sheet.

The following steps are standard for interior painting :

1. Move furniture.
2. Cover furniture and floors.
3. Remove unwanted nails, fill small holes, and cracks in walls (large cracks will be taped) *
4. Seal and prime as needed.
5. Apply finish coats. (unless specified differently walls and trim receive two coats and ceilings receive one coat of flat ceiling paint)

* Additional repairs will be completed
according to contract specifications.

You are responsible for the following unless otherwise stated in the estimate:

1. Removing all knick knacks, pictures, and other small items from areas to be painted.
2. Clearing kitchen counters and sink.
3. Selecting colors prior to the start date of the project.
4. If wallpaper is to be removed prior to my starting the job all glue must be removed and walls must be ready for paint.

Thank you for your help. Anything you don't feel you can do please let me know prior to the start of the job and it can be added into the estimate.

Wallpaper removal bids include the following:

1. The removal of one layer of paper installed with standard water soluble wallpaper paste over a properly prepared wall.
2. The removal of all glue .
3. up to 15 minutes per room for normal patching of walls.
